5. Starting permission (qualification) for IAEC:

5.1. Groups:

There is only one group for each, male and female.
There is no restriction of age.

5.2. Quotas for each nation:

For their home races, the quota of each nation increases:
+20 f or m.

Further the local organizer receives „wildcards“: 10 f or m.
It is recommended to distribute the wildcards to the best not-qualified athletes of a potential pre-race the day before, or to famous skiing athletes

5.3. Starting permission (qualification) for 2nd leg:

30f 50m

Times of both legs have to be added.

In 2nd leg, athletes start according to their results of 1st leg

The athletes have to be nominated by the national responsible, and transmitted to IAEC-responsible for evaluation Wolf-Dieter Plass at least one week before the race takes place. The starting list is online available on Tuesday before the race-weekend.

5.6. Starting passport/declaration of athletes: (-> Download:)

All Athletes need either a starting passport of their national association (The number of the starting passport has to be mentioned at registration) or a subscribed declaration of athletes, that has to be submitted to the local organizer before the race.

5.7. Starting fee:

The starting fee for European Cup races amounts 12 Euros per athlete and has to be paid to the local organizer by the clubs.

6. Race Performance:

6.1. Start sequencing IA-European Cup:

1st leg:

- according to international point list, ending with the best one.

2. Durchgang:

- 30 females according to their performance of the 1st leg, ending with the best one.

- 50 males according to their performance of the 1st leg, ending with the best one

6.6. winners ceremony at each MOVEMAX-IA-Europacup-event:

The best 10 females and best 10 males are to be honored, while the 3 best ones, have to be mentioned extraordinary. The flags of each three winner nations are hoisted.

The national anthem of the winner nation is played.

The prizes (money, trophies, flowers, etc.) are granted by the local organizer.

6.7. overall winners ceremony of MOVEMAX-IAEC 2005:

The overall winners male/female obtain the title „Inline-Alpine-European-Cup-winners 2005“; The overall best 10 athletes male/female are honored with trophies, provided by the IAEC-committee. The overall winners ceremony takes place after the last IAEC race at Unterensingen.

For the overall evaluation the IAEC-committee provides an amount of 3300 Euros for prize money.
